A 165-Mile Walk from Boeing in Chicago to the Air National Guard in Battle Creek to end the illegal and immoral use of drones as weapons of war.

Please join our walk along Lake Michigan's south shore and through southwest Michigan, a protest against drone warfare. We'll be walking 15 miles per day for 11 days: about 165 miles from Chicago to the Michigan Air National Guard base in Battle Creek, proposed site of a new drone command center.

We'll need help in locating venues for speaking events along the route, for members of the public who would like to hear from Voices activists about the impacts of drones. Several of the activists will have just returned from visiting Afghanistan, and they will talk of their experience in the country.

We will also need people who can help us find places to sleep along the route, including churches, community centers, private homes, etc.
