WITNESS AGAINST WAR: A 450 MILE WALK FROM CHICAGO TO SAINT PAUL IN WAUKESHA ON JULY 22

WHAT: Witness Against War, a 450 mile walk to educate the public on the planned deployment of the Wisconsin National Guard to Iraq war, will be in Waukesha on July 22.

WHY: Witness Against War is a 450 mile walk from Chicago to Saint Paul intended to promote dialogue and to build opposition to the Iraq war. Participants include those with first hand experience in Iraq, including those with Voices for Creative Nonviolence and with Iraq Veterans Against the War. Witness Against War calls for the complete withdrawal of U.S. military forces from Iraq, the highest quality health care for veterans and full U.S. funding for the reconstruction of Iraq.
